

THE MAIN AIMS OF THE BEHAVIOUR and ANTI-BULLYING POLICIES STILL APPLY BUT DURING THE CURRENT SITUATION OF COVID 19, ALL PUPILS MUST STRICTLY ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES AND PROCEDURES. FAMILY GROUP ADULTS MUST STILL FOLLOW THE POSITIVE PRAISE OUTLINED IN THE SCHOOL BEHAVIOUR POLICY.

Staff will reward good social behaviour by:

- smiling
- thumbs up
- verbal praise (make sure that it is task specific .e.g Joe, I like the way that you are washing your hands)
- whole class clap
- virtual high five/hug

Expectations

Children will be reminded about expectations for behaviour throughout the school day, especially first thing in the morning, before break and lunchtimes and at the end of the school day.

We will:

- Keep socially distanced – 2m as much as possible.
- Only sit in our designated seat.
- Not deliberately touch anyone or anything that does not belong to use.
- Not spit at anyone.
- If possible, we will try to not touch our face throughout the day.
- Only use our own individual equipment.
- Never leave our Family Group/Family Group classroom, unless accompanied by an adult.
- Ask an adult to use the toilet and wait until they are able to accompany us- adults to follow instructions in Staff Handbook.
- Let an adult know if we are feeling unwell – adults to follow instructions in Staff Handbook.

Hygiene

We will:

- Follow the ‘Catch it, bin it, kill it’ rules when we blow our nose and will place all tissues in the pedal bin. If this is not possible, we must cough or sneeze into our elbow or sleeve.
- Follow all rules displayed in posters around school- Family Group adults to constantly remind pupils about the posters. E.g good hand washing.

Outside break/lunch times

We will:

- Always listen to and respect the instructions of my supervising adult.
- Stay within our Family Group area(s) at all times –classroom, playground/back grass at timetabled times only.
- Play and socialise at a safe distance (2 meters) only with other children in my Family Group.
- Not use the MUGA, the gym equipment and the KS1 play area due to health and safety reasons.
- Not play direct contact games e.g - horse play, hugging or high fives.
- .Only eat our own food.

Movement around school

We will:

- Walk in a single file line 2m apart on the left hand side of corridors.

- Not touch or lean on walls as we move around school.
- Never walk around school unless supervised by an adult from my Family Group.
- At the end of the day, I will line up 2m apart and wait in an orderly line for my name to be called. I must immediately walk to the adult who is collecting me.
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Home Schooling

We will:

- Continue to communicate with our class teachers.
- Continue to follow home learning expectations and work that is set by school.
- Continue to stay safe when working online – parents and staff to read Online Safety Policy Amendment.

Consequences

- If a child is unable to follow the guidelines in this policy, a risk assessment may need to be written for the pupil.
- Continuation of the pupil's non-compliance to follow the behaviour expectations and impacting on the spread of infection the child's offer of a place at school will be withdrawn.
- Each case will be dealt with individually.

Monitoring and Review of the Policy Amendment.

The school will review this policy and will assess its implementation and effectiveness two weeks from 8th June.
